 - Tallahassee: One (1) Meeting

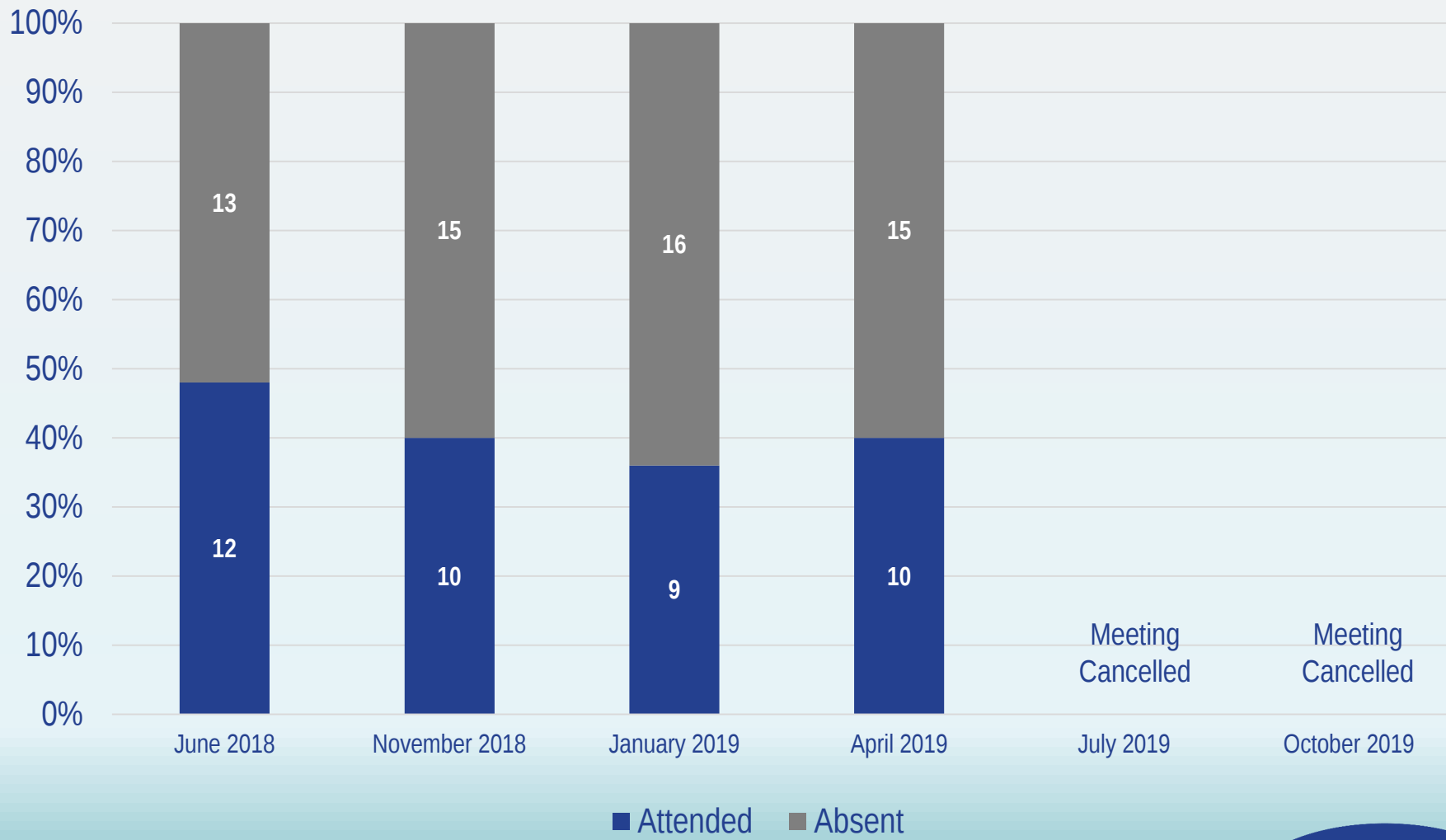

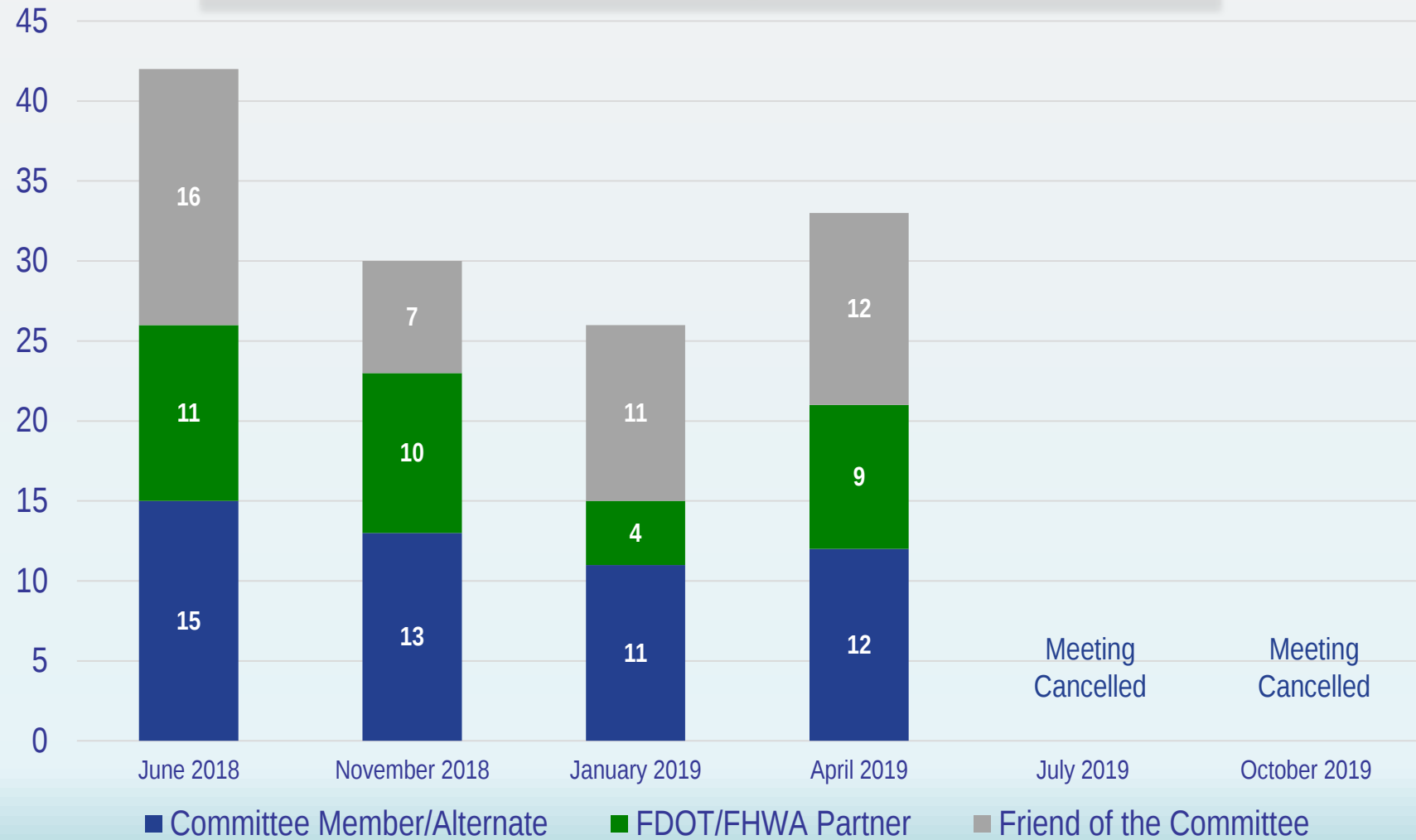
